**Working for Change** is seeking a Manager to lead the operations of the Out of This World Cafe - a social enterprise that employs people with lived experience of mental health, substance use issues, survivors of trauma and violence, newcomers to Canada, and groups systemically marginalized from work due to discrimination and barriers leading to chronic poverty (including those with lived experience of homelessness). The Cafe is located within the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) at 100 Stokes Street.

**Duties**

- Creating menus, standard recipes, and specials for the retail food service and catering operations.
- Overseeing ordering of food and supplies for the Cafe and monitoring costs
- Overseeing and participating in the preparation of food for the Cafe and catering orders
- Scheduling, and supervising staff for all operations
- Ensuring compliance with municipal health and safety codes

**Qualifications**

- Experience managing a food service/café
- Superior skills in human resource management
- Formal culinary training/post-secondary education or equivalent experience
- Excellent communication skills
- Experience cooking in a fast-paced kitchen environment
- Ability to manage a diverse staff team
- Time-management, organizational, administrative, and problem-solving skills.
- Identifies as having lived experience (as falls under the above categories), has an applied understanding of survivor communities, and an ability to work with the challenges and opportunities that lived experiences offer.

This is a Temporary Full-Time position, starting at a 3-month contract with strong chance of extension. You will be given a minimum of 1 month notice prior to the contract ending. You must be fully vaccinated (2 weeks since your second dose) against COVID-19 to be considered for the position.
