Out of This World Café & Catering Part-Time Driver

Working for Change is seeking a part time driver to assist the operations of the Out of This World College St Café & Catering food social enterprise, which employs people with lived experience of mental health challenges; addiction; homelessness; gendered violence; and / or refugee challenges. The pickup location is at 250 College St with multiple delivery addresses in the downtown core.

Responsibilities:

- Timely, reliable daily pick-up and delivery of prepared meals to our partners;
- Professional and courteous interaction with our partners;
- Careful handling of food and materials;
- Ensuring correct orders are delivered to corresponding locations;
- Provide sufficient notice if unable to make a shift;
- Provide up to date communications if deliveries are delayed for any reason;
- Safe driving throughout the downtown area.

Qualifications:

- Driver's License and clean driver's abstract a requirement;
- Lived experience and applied understanding of survivorhood, its challenges and opportunities;
- Excellent communication skills;
- Experience driving in the downtown area during busy periods;
- Time-management.

Role-Related Workplace Provision:

- Working for Change can provide a vehicle if you do not own one or contribute to your mileage for personal vehicle usage. A mid-sized transport vehicle is necessary for deliveries (eg, minivan, SUV).

Temporary Part Time, approx. 12-15 hours per week. Rate of pay \$16/hour.

Hours of work are normally Monday to Friday 11am-2pm. There may be some variation with hours and locations due to business requirements. You must be fully vaccinated (2 weeks since your second dose) against COVID-19 to be considered for the position. Mask wearing is currently required when interacting with other staff and customers during pick-up and drop-off of food items.
